

Developing Apps Using Visual C# 2005: Additional Topics

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Course description: In this course you will learn about important development topics that are not normally covered in a beginning Windows application programming course. Starting with saving objects to a stream using .NET Serialization and creating and displaying reports, you will work through crucial topics such as attributes and reflection, programming XML using the XmlDocument class, and the XmlReader/XmlWriter classes, creating Windows Services, and drawing your own user interfaces using the System.Drawing namespace. You will see how to handle vital distribution issues, learning about application security, versioning, and deployment. You will dig deeper into working with the most complex of the built-in controls of Visual Studio, the DataGridView control, how to extend Visual Studio 2005 in a number of different ways, get started building mobile applications, and how to interact with printers and how to print documents. You are certain to find many topics here that will extend your knowledge, your capabilities, and your value as a developer.
